

BY-LAW ARTICLE XV
Bowling

Sect. 1: Bowling shall be administered by the NHIAA Bowling Committee and the rules of the USBC will govern the sport when applicable.

Sect. 2: Only member schools of the NHIAA will be permitted to enter either teams or individuals.

Sect. 3: The NHIAA Bowling Committee shall select sites, dates, and format for the State Bowling Tournament. The rules governing play shall be those adopted and written by the USBC for ten-pin bowling.

Sect. 4: Awards

Individual medals will be awarded to the top four competitors in each bracket. There will be two brackets, defined as, an average of below 150, and an average of 150 and above.

Sect. 5: Classification of Schools

Bowling schools will compete as a co-ed sport in (1) division.

Sect. 6: Criteria of Play

The format will follow that set forth by the USBC for American ten-pin bowling. Competition will utilize the Baker System which is a modified format consisting of teams of two or more bowlers. Games will consist of 10 frames. Candlepin bowling is not sanctioned under this By-Law.

Sect. 7: Tournament Selection

Tournament selection will be initiated as determined by the Bowling Committee. For the 2009-10 school year only individual competition will be recognized in the State Tournament and there will be no team champion or runner-up.
