

BY-LAW ARTICLE XVII

Bowling

Ten-Pin

Sect. 1: Bowling shall be administered by the NHIAA Bowling Committee and the rules of the USBC High School Rulebook will govern the sport when applicable.

Sect. 2: Only member schools of the NHIAA will be permitted to enter either teams or individuals.

Sect. 3: The NHIAA Bowling Committee shall select sites, dates, and format for the State Bowling Tournament. The rules governing play shall be those adopted and written by the USBC High School Rulebook for ten-pin bowling.

Sect. 4: Awards

Official NHIAA championship and runner-up plaques in addition to 12 team medals will be awarded to the respective champion and runner-up. There will be two (2) flights, defined as, the Championship Flight and the Medal Flight. Individual medals will be awarded to the top four (4) competitors in each flight.

Sect. 5: Divisional Alignment

Bowling schools shall be aligned in one (1) division as a co-ed sport.

Sect. 6: Criteria of Play

The format will follow that set forth by the USBC for American ten-pin bowling. Competition will utilize the Baker System which is a modified format consisting of teams of two (2) or more bowlers. Games will consist of ten (10) frames.

Sect. 7: Tournament Selection

A team is required to compete in a minimum of seven (7) and maximum of 14 games/events to qualify for the State Meet. An individual is required to compete/score in a minimum of 14 and maximum of 28 games/events to qualify for the Individual and Team State Meets. Please refer to the Bowling Policies and Procedures Manual for qualifying scores and selection for the State Meet determined by the Bowling Committee.
