

BY-LAW ARTICLE XXVIII

Skiing – Alpine

Boys and Girls

Sect. 1: Skiing shall be administered by the NHIAA Ski Committee and the rules of the National Federation will govern the sport when applicable.

Sect. 2: Eligibility for competition in the State Meet is limited to those schools, which are members of the NHIAA.

Sect. 3: Divisional Alignment

Alpine skiing shall be aligned into four (4) divisions based upon enrollments and petitions subject to the approval of the Classification Committee.

Sect. 4: The Skiing Policies and Procedures Manual will provide specific information on the conduct of ski meets during the regular season and the State Divisional Championships. The state ski championships shall be held the first full week (Monday-Friday) prior to President's Day each year.

Sect. 5: At the State Divisional Championships schools and/or competitors may compete only in designated divisional competition.

Sect. 6: Awards

Divisional: Official NHIAA championship and runner-up plaques shall be awarded to championship and runner-up teams in each division for boys and girls. The competition shall include slalom and giant slalom events.

Medal Awards: Official NHIAA medals shall be awarded to the top three (3) competitors for boys and girls in each Division I, II, III and IV in slalom and giant slalom.

Divisional Skimeister Awards: Individual skimeister medals shall be awarded to the top three (3) competitors for boys and girls in Division I, II, III and IV who compete in the two (2) alpine disciplines of slalom and giant slalom and the two (2) cross-country disciplines of freestyle and classical.

Sect. 7: Meet of Champions

The top ten (10) competitors in slalom and giant slalom for boys and girls will advance to the Meet of Champions.

Medal Awards: Individual medals will be awarded to the top six (6) competitors in each event for boys and girls.
