IMPORTANT INFORMATION NEW THIS YEAR

ONLINE ENTRY FEE / REGISTRATION PAYMENT

- 1) All entry/registration fees must be paid **ONLINE prior to the meet.** There are no refunds.
- 2) Entry fee is \$20 per wrestler /plus processing fee.
- 3) Only two (2) coaches from each team will be admitted without charge. Every coach above the initial 2 will be charged a fee of \$20.00 per coach plus processing fee, up to a max of 5 coaches per school.
- 4) Deadline for entry/registration fee payment is 8:00 pm on Thursday March 6th 2025. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 5) Only wrestler who are on their State Official entry form submitted to KAP wrestling will be entered into the meet.

Note: The Wrestler **CAN NOT** weigh-in unless the fee is paid online.

Coaches, please note the following:

1. At Packet Pick Up, all registered coaches and participating wrestlers must arrive at the same time on Saturday morning. Due to the sheer volume and time constants, the event staff can no longer process them separately or hold credentials for coaches as in the past. Please be sure that you, your athletes & coaches plan accordingly.

2. Coaches will be issued wristbands on Saturday and must retain the wristband for entrance on Sunday. There will be no exceptions. Without the wristband on Sunday, you will pay the general admission fee at the main gate.

<u>PACKET PICK-UP:</u> The facility will be open for athletes and coaches at <u>9:00 AM.</u> ONLY registered Coaches & participating Wrestlers will check in at the side entrance from Cranston St. (front of the school is on Fricker St.). Packets will contain CNESSPA pins, certificates and day two ticket for entry for all registered competitors.

All others, including non-participating wrestlers, non-registered coaches, managers etc. <u>MUST</u> purchase an e-ticket and enter through the main gate.

Note: Alternates will be accepted until 8:00 pm, Thursday, March,6th. Only wrestlers officially entered by state representatives may compete. <u>All wrestlers must qualify by placing at their state</u> <u>championship.</u>

ENTRIES:

- A. **State Reps Only**: Please Email, by 2:00 PM on Sunday, March 2nd, your typed entries to: info@kapwrestling.com. Please provide correct names and spelling. This is very important. If there is a problem, call Desi at 978-866-8665.
- B. It is most important that the entries be submitted no later than 2:00 PM for scheduled program development, bracket production, and t-shirts.
- C. Please Note: In the event of scratches made after the 8pm deadline on Thursday, March 6th 2025, or wrestlers failing to make weight, ALTERNATES will <u>NOT</u> be accepted or added at the event on Saturday. There will be NO changes or additions after the final deadline at 8:00 pm on <u>Thursday March</u> 6th 2025
- D. Pigtail wrestlers will be moved to fill the bracket when necessary. The tournament coordinator has final say on the movement of wrestlers. His decision will be final with no appeal. His professional judgment will be honored.

ARRIVAL:

Please do not arrive at the Providence Career and Technical Academy (PCTA) before (8:45Am) on Saturday March 8th and 7:45 AM on Sunday. Please DO NOT arrive early, as you will not be allowed entry. The gym will not be available on Friday.

ADMISSION:

\$10 per day for everyone at the spectator entrance. The spectator gate will open at 9:30 am on Saturday. Admission for spectators on Saturday and Sunday will be through the **front entrance from Fricker St**. Gates will open at 8:15 am on Sunday. **We will only be using ONLINE TICKETS** and there will be no cash accepted at the gate.

PROGRAM:

A program will be posted online at www.cnesspa.com a day or two prior to the event.

RULES:

National Federation Rules, 14 weight classes, Girls 12 weight classes

- **Weigh-ins will take place on **Both Saturday & Sunday.**
- 4 lbs. weight allowance on Saturday (example 106 = 110).
- 1 lb. weight allowance on Sunday (example 106 = 111).

The New England Seeding Chart is used to place all wrestlers in the bracket.

SCORING:

The tournament will be double elimination to 3rd place. Team scoring will start in the 32-man bracket. All bouts will be scored. Scoring: 16-12-9-7-5-3. We will wrestle to 6 places in each weight class.

CONSOLATIONS:

This is a double elimination tournament. All wrestlers will have a minimum of two matches. Consolation matches will be 1-2-2 minutes until the medal round (2-2-2 minutes).

WRESTLING FORMAT:

Ten mats will be used. Bouts will be assigned to mats continuously starting at the lowest weight class and working up. Every effort will be made to adhere to the tournament schedule.

AWARDS:

It is the coach's responsibility to have their wrestlers present and properly dressed for the awards ceremony, which will take place throughout the championship finals. There are trophies for the top three teams plus individual awards for the top 6 place finishers in each weight class. There is also an Outstanding Wrestler trophy, and an Outstanding Finals Bout award (both wrestlers receive).

COACHES DRESS CODE:

Dress Code Guidelines: Dress, polo or collared shirt with slacks. No jeans or hats permitted while a coach is in the wrestler's corner.

T-SHIRTS:

Official New England Wrestling Championship apparel will be sold at the meet. Apparel can be pre-ordered at https://www.grrteesmsp.com/ until the Wednesday before the Meet and post-ordered beginning on Monday after the Meet.

Seeding Chart

Note - Tournament Seeding Chart will be selected and posted on the CNESSPA website once all entries have been submitted and reviewed by Tournament Directors.

Seeding the State Champs for the New England Wrestling Tournament

The following seeding process attempts to separate State Champion wrestlers who are returning NE place winners, such that it will reduce the chances of the top wrestlers meeting in the quarters or semis (as opposed to the finals).

- 1. Only the 6 state champions will be considered for seeding. All others will be placed according to one of the pre-determined brackets that do an excellent job of separating wrestlers from the same state.
- 2. The only state champions who will be considered for seeding are those current champs who are prior-year NE place winners OR any current state champion who, during the current HS season, has beaten a current state champion from another NE state who was a prior-year NE place winner.
- 3. Some weight classes may wind up with 2 or 3 seeds, while others may have none (or could perhaps have even 5 or 6). Again, the goal is separation, so please don't become overly focused on whether the "top seed" is on line 1 or on the 2nd seed line...as long as 2 is on the same bracket side as #3 (and not on #1 side), and 2 & 3 would meet in semis, not quarters...
- 4. While a weight class may not be fully seeded 1-6, it will also be the goal such that the top 2 seeded wrestlers in any weight are not paired in the same quarterfinal bracket as any of the other state champions (essentially attempting to ensure that any state champ is placed on what would be a 1-6 seeding, whereby a 5th or 6th "seed" would not see the #1 or #2 seed in the quarters, but rather might face a 3 or 4 seed.
- 5. No other tournament placings will be considered for seeding purposes, including Fargo or NHSCA. Only regular season meetings during the current high school season between current state champions will be considered for purposes of jumping above a higher seeded state champ.
- 6. Seeding Criteria:
 - A. First criteria will be previous year's NE tourney placement. The higher the finish, the higher the seed.
 - B. Only in the case of a tie (equal finish in prior year's NE tourney at different weight classes), the first tie-breaker will be head-to-head. If still tied, the only common opponents that will be considered are the other state champs from current season. If still tied, the tiebreaker will go to the wrestler who was at the higher weight class in prior year's NE tournament.

- C. Once any of the 6 state champs who were NE place winners from the past season are seeded according to #6 above, the opportunity for any other state champ who was NOT a previous year NE place winner to improve their seed by virtue of having beaten a seeded state champ (therefore, a prior year NE placer) during the current season (without also having lost to that wrestler, unless such loss still maintained a "2 out of 3" advantage). Such wrestler may move above the other state champ that was defeated provided they have not lost to any other seeded state champs that are currently seeded below the wrestler who was beaten. In such event, the highest said wrestler may be seeded will be above any other state champions who were NOT seeded according to aforementioned criteria.
- 8. Finally, at this point, direct flips may occur for any of those who are now seeded who have beaten a seeded wrestler above them, using the same process that was used in #7.
- 9. Once all wrestlers who MAY be seeded are now SEEDED, it is time to select a seeding chart from the existing master grid (using options A-N) that best achieves the desired separation. If more than one plan meets the desired criteria, a random draw will be conducted to choose the chart. In the event that the number of wrestlers who are seeded at any weight class exceeds the capability of an exact match within the 14 charts from the grid, the preference will be given to the one that best separates the greater number of the top seeds, starting with 1 and 2 and continuing down. For example, if 5 wrestlers are seeded, and 1 chart works for seeds 1, 2 and 3, and another works for 1, 5 and 6, the one that works for 1,2 and 3 will be chosen. Again, the key is separation on the seeding chart (and not a concern with top half or bottom half of bracket directly corresponding to #1 and #2 seeds, despite how that may confuse fans).
- 11. If no returning wrestlers are "seed able" based on the criteria of being a returning NE place winner from the previous season, the grid selected will be the one that corresponds with the weight class, as we will continue to move the grid backwards one weight class each season.
- 12. If there is a scratch of a state champ who was seeded according to the criteria above, the remaining state champs who met seeding criteria will be "bumped up", with the 2nd place finisher who is replacing that state's champion seeded below the other 5 state champions, without the ability to improve seed.
